East Side Union High School District Seeks Applicants for the Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee

The East Side Union High School District (ESUHSD) is recruiting applicants to serve on the Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee (CBOC). This committee, for a number of years, has been actively involved with assuring the community that the funds expended are in alignment with the voter approved ballot measure. The committee's input and annual publication has assisted the community in knowing what opportunities for students have been created with their tax dollars.

Measures G, E, I, Technology I, Z, and N were passed under the rules of Proposition 39, which directs the Board of Trustees to appoint a Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee to monitor bond expenditures. This Committee is responsible for reviewing expenditures related to the general obligation bonds passed by voters.

The Committee meets four times a year in January, April, July, and October at one of the District's high schools. Members have the opportunity to tour recently completed projects and project sites in construction. Committee members receive information and updates on bond-funded projects in progress throughout the District.

Members serve two-year terms and are allowed to serve three (3) consecutive terms. Members whose terms are expiring, and have served less than three terms, are eligible to reapply. A committee made up of two Board of Trustees members and two CBOC members will review the applications and conduct the interviews.

No employee or official of the District can be appointed to the Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee. Also, vendors, contractors, or consultants of the District are not allowed to serve as members of the Committee.
